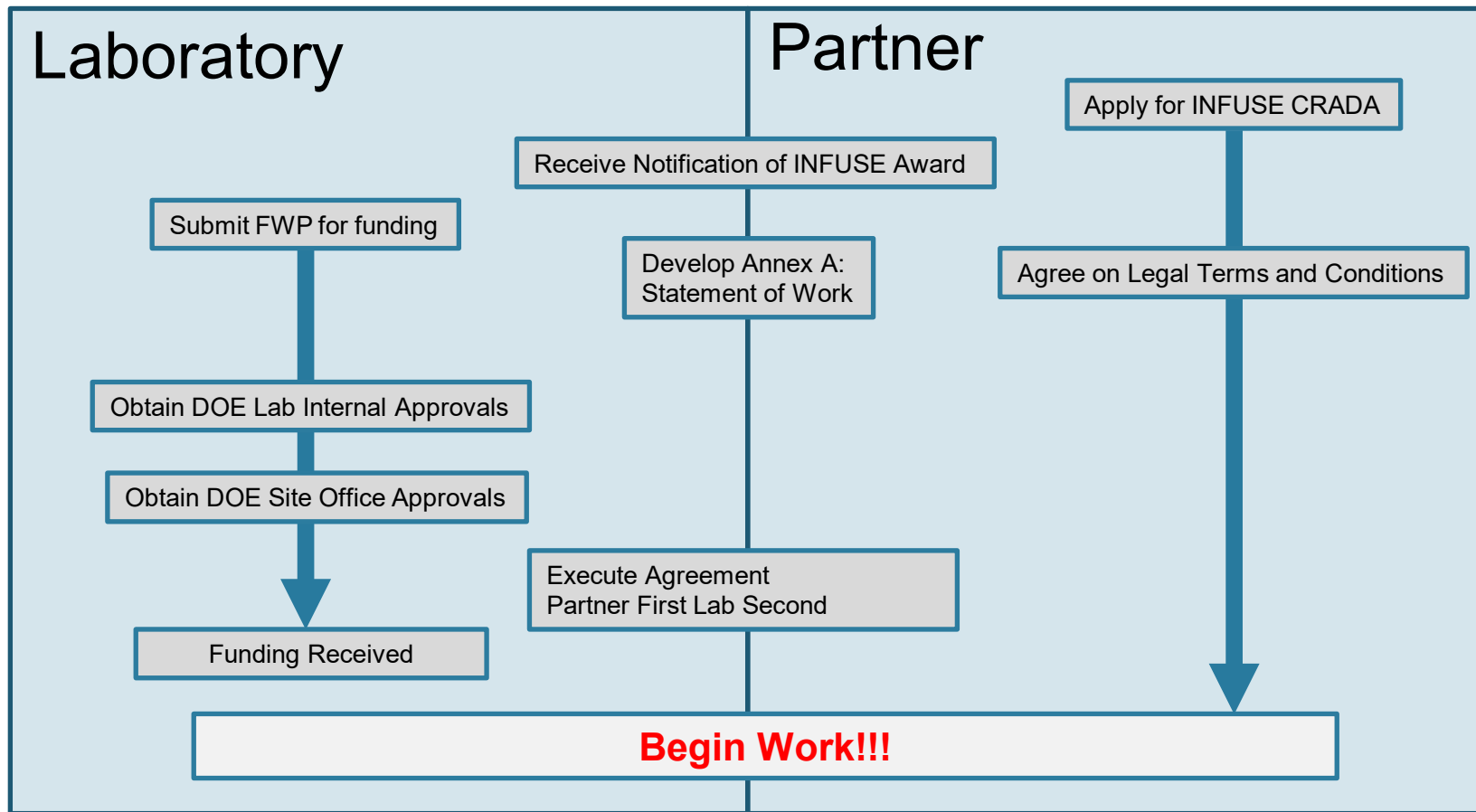

CRADA

- An Agreement between a U.S. Gov't Agency and another party to perform joint research
 - Various federal agencies have their own “flavors” of CRADAs.
- A DOE CRADA supports collaborative research between a DOE lab and a partner
 - Must be joint research with contributions from the lab and the CRADA partner
- The DOE CRADA Order 483.1B defines the DOE CRADAs
 - Note that the INFUSE CRADA has its own template and rules
 - Note that the INFUSE application process requires applicants to: “. . . Certify that they accept one of the standardized CRADA Agreements”
 - INFUSE Small Business Award CRADA
 - DOE-Standard INFUSE CRADA (for large businesses and foreign controlled businesses)

INFUSE CRADA Pointers

- Allow enough time for the project to complete under the contract
- Export Control issues can add time
 - If you have questions during the process -> ASK
- Finalize the legal language as quickly possible!
- The Statement of Work
 - Brief
 - Include Deliverables
 - For the Lab
 - For the Partner
 - Remember that Annex A (SOW) of the CRADA agreement is part of a legal document.
 - The Annex serves a different function than a work plan for the project
